WHEN ARE WE GOING?

JULY 11-18, 2026

WHY ARE WE GOING?

Catch the Vision International builds communities and assists families through development and evangelism in villages along the Amazon River. Mt. Horeb has adopted seven villages, which means providing medical outposts, church buildings and projects, school buildings and projects, monthly community-wide evangelism dinners, a weekly youth Bible school program and safe water implementation and delivery.

On this trip, the students will witness Mt. Horeb's partnership with Catch the Vision and participate in their community development programs. We will be engaging with the community through a children's sports camp, community painting projects and some light construction projects. In nearby villages, we will have the opportunity to evangelize and share the gospel.

WHAT IS THE COST?

STUDENTS: \$2500

ADULTS: \$2500

Included expenses:

- Partner base cost
- In-country meals
- Lodging
- All travel and flight/travel insurance (departing airport will be CAE, ATL or CLT)

Unincluded expenses:

- Meals during travel
- Passport that expires after Dec. 18, 2026
- Vaccinations*

You can view CDC's recommendations and requirements for Liberia at <https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel>. Talk to your doctor first about vaccinations. Local Columbia vaccination clinics, Prisma Health Travel Clinic and Passport Health, are by appointment only. Make sure to plan for vaccinations as it may take time to schedule an appointment. The vaccinations can also be very costly, so plan for a minimum of an additional \$300. Once vaccinated, make sure to include your Yellow Vaccination Card with your passport for travel.

HOW WILL I FUND THIS TRIP?

Students should consider the following ways of raising support in order to cover their trip cost: simple living, personal fundraising and support letters.

We do not want cost to keep someone from going on mission. Team Members that are Mt. Horeb members and active attendees, will have the option to apply for a financial scholarship for up to 40% of the final trip cost. Individuals will need to do all they can to fund their entire trip prior to asking for a scholarship. The Scholarship Application will be distributed by the Team Leader a few weeks before departure.

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Medical Considerations

Because there are risks involved in participating in any mission trip and healthcare facilities may be inadequate or nonexistent, a Physician Release Form is required for all team members.

We cannot provide medical advice as it relates to vaccinations or prescriptions for travel. Team members may search for Peru on the Center for Diseases Control's website for a list of required vaccinations. Medical decisions should be made under the care of a medical professional.

If you have dietary or allergy concerns, feel free to touch base with the Team Leader prior to applying.

APPLICATION & DEPOSIT

APPLICATION DEADLINE: JANUARY 28, 2026

DEPOSIT: \$300

The deposit is non-refundable and applies to your overall trip cost if accepted. A deposit does not guarantee your acceptance. To be accepted, a student must be a regular attender of the Mt. Horeb Student Ministry or worship attendee, have the application turned in and deposit paid. Both the *application and deposit* must be received for a person to be considered for any team.
