# WHY ARE WE GOING?

This week-long mission trip to Savannah focuses on community development. We will engage in work projects, such as painting and repairing homes. These efforts provide immediate relief and stability to families in need.

Our team will be involved in home repair projects that reach out to those in need during an ongoing housing crisis in Savannah. We will work in neighborhoods with a diverse group of people and circumstances. Team members will have the opportunity to share their lives through service, prayer and time spent with the families and children they work with.

In Savannah, teams will serve a portion of their day supporting the Salvation Army and their ministries. These include children's ministry & other social outreaches. Experience Mission may hold an organized Kids Club, depending on the specific needs of the week we serve.

Horeb Student Ministry or worship attendee, have the application turned in and deposit paid. Both the application and deposit must be received for a person to be considered for any team.

Students from other churches will be considered if space is available starting mid-spring.
